

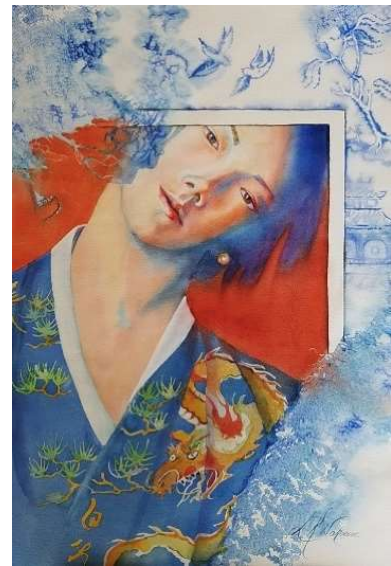

EXPLORING TEXTURE IN WATERCOLOR

In this demo we will look at ways of adding texture to watercolor paintings by pushing the physics of the painting process. We will explore granulating pigments and mediums, altering the surface tension of the paper and how to leverage capillary action to create and manage blossoms and lifting. Watercolor pigments vary widely in their ability to create texture and Linda will provide attendees with a list of her favorites and their capabilities. Linda will demonstrate and provide examples of how these techniques can be used to enhance a variety of subjects and painting styles.

Linda Wokoun, watermedia artist based in Southwest Florida, leverages the natural characteristics of water to bring energy and movement to her paintings. She likes to incorporate both abstract and representational elements in her work and believes that watermedia is particularly well suited to her approach. She is a member of the Florida Watercolor Society and the Transparent Watercolor Society of America where she has also exhibited.
