It's an honor to serve as your President this year. My intention is to have a live Convention in Punta Gorda. I think we have a lovely venue in the Charlotte Harbor Conference and Event Center. There is ample space for all of our convention needs with a beautiful view of Charlotte Harbor. Our Board is hard at work planning an exciting time for you with all the things you look forward to, demos, Tradeshow, workshops, paint-a-round, critiques and much more. The Convention will be held September 22nd through the 25th. Workshops will begin on September 19th. There will be two four day workshops, one by Mark Mehaffey and the other by Bob Burrridge, two outstanding workshop instructors. A two day workshop will be taught by Lynn Ferris and a one day workshop instructed by Jim Beech. Lynn Ferris and Jim Beech are both Signature members of FWS and teachers as well as workshop instructors.

The 51st Annual Exhibition will be held at the Visual Arts Center in Punta Gorda. This is a special year for the VAC, it's their 60th Anniversary. I feel honored that we can help them celebrate this milestone with our exhibition in their galleries. It will run September 14th through November 14th. The reception will be Friday evening September 23rd.

For all information and to register for the workshops and convention please visit www.floridawatercolorociety.org Workshop registration opens Tuesday, March 1st for FWS members and Friday, April 1st for non-members.

Are you interested in upping the stakes for the 2023 non-signature member online show? This year we will be asking membership if they would like to also offer a one-time, one point award towards Signature status (more information on that in the Exhibition Director's report below). If you are a non-signature member who did not win an award in the Annual Exhibition don't miss out on this opportunity, pending membership approval. Enter the Online Show which will be juried by Bob Burrridge. The window for entry is October 3rd through December 7th 2022.

Jerome Chesley has secured two locations for our Traveling Show this year, the Wirtz Gallery in Miami, November 14th through December 31st, 2022 and Ormond Memorial Art Gallery and Gardens in Ormond Beach, January 4th through February 26th, 2023. You can opt in to participate in the Traveling Show when you enter your painting into the Annual Exhibition. It's a prestigious show and offers excellent exposure for your art.

The Charlotte Harbor Conference and Event Center does not have a hotel affiliated with it. However, there are four hotels within walking distance of the Center. The Sheraton Four Points and the Springhill Suites by Marriott both offer group discounts when booking Event Center space. If you reserve one of those hotels let them know that you are with FWS. These two are the closest to the Event Center. The other two hotels within walking distance are the Wyvern Hotel and the PG Hotel. You will be responsible for booking your own hotel.

I am really looking forward to having our membership together again in Punta Gorda for our 51st Annual Convention and Tradeshow. See you there!

We are working on a monthly virtual demo series with Q&A done by our 2022 Convention instructors, Mark Mehaffey, Bob Burrridge, Lynn Ferris and Jim Beech. Watch the website and emails for further updates.

2022 FWS CONVENTION, EXHIBITION & TRADE SHOW PUNTA GORDA, FL, SEPTEMBER 19-25, 2022

Convention, Workshops & Trade Show will be held at the
Charlotte Harbor Conference and Event Center

The Annual Exhibition will be held at the Visual Arts Center of Punta Gorda

I'm keeping my fingers crossed in hopes that finally in 2022, Florida Watercolor Society will have a live Convention and Trade Show in Punta Gorda. The Convention and Trade Show will take place at the Charlotte Harbor Conference and Event Center in downtown Punta Gorda, September 22-25, 2022, and the Exhibition will be on view at the Visual Arts Center also in Punta Gorda from September 12th through November 14th, 2022. This Convention will be a little different in that it will be held at a conference center, not a hotel, but there are four hotels within walking distance to the conference center.

We have an exciting lineup of judges and workshop instructors. There will be four workshops scheduled; two 4-day workshops, September 19-22nd, one 2-day workshop September 21-22nd, and a 1-day workshop, September 22nd.



I'm excited to announce that **Mark Mehaffey**, AWS, NWS, TWSA will be our juror and judge. He is a national and international award-winning watercolor artist whose paintings are included in corporate, public and private collections around the world. His workshop, "Experiment for Fun, Design for Success", will run the gamut from representational to experimental, intuitive, abstraction. This will be a fast moving, fun, mixed media workshop. All skill levels are welcome.

Bob Burrridge will be our online judge and workshop instructor. He was an award-winning Industrial Designer, who focused his life to painting every day. His work hangs in permanent collections internationally and nationally. He is a highly sought-after workshop instructor. Learn to get creative in a whole new way in Bob's workshop, "Loosen Up". Think "artist retreat" as you produce a body of work, a series of paintings, or your conceptual solo show. "Come prepared to paint your stuff."



2022 1-DAY AND 2-DAY WORKSHOPS



Lynn Ferris, AWS, NWS, TWSA, FWS will offer a two-day workshop. Lynn is an award-winning artist whose work has been featured in *The Watercolor Magazine* and *The Art of Watercolour*. She teaches to sold-out audiences both nationally and internationally. You will learn about the importance of light in your painting in her workshop “Capturing the Light”.

Jim Beech, FWS will conduct a one-day workshop titled, “The Importance of Detail”. He is an award-winning representational watercolor artist and instructor. In this workshop, you will learn to really pay attention to important details that make your painting believable and learn how to use simple symbols to show detail.



In addition to these wonderful workshops, there will be our many inspiring demos, the infamous Trade Show, Mark Mehaffey’s Exhibition Review, Friday night’s Reception at the Visual Arts Center, the Paint-Around, and much more.

Hello Artists!

I'm so excited to be the new Exhibitions Director for Florida Watercolor Society. Once I began learning the job from Jedi Master Robin, I realized I will be spending 2022 on my toes. I hope to live up to what Robin has done for the last seven years. If all goes well, maybe I can hang around for that long.

I've recently returned from the FWS Board Meeting in Punta Gorda, and I'm so excited for the 51st Annual Exhibition and all the events surrounding it during the FWS Convention. The room where some of you will receive awards and be acknowledged for your Signature Membership is truly lovely. If you decide to attend the FWS Convention for the first time this year, you will be amazed at the Trade Show, dazzled by the demos, and connect with some of the best watercolor artists in the country!

The prospectus for our 51st Annual Exhibition is in its final stages and will soon be available on the FWS website. An email will come out as soon as it is viewable there. I look forward to entries pouring in and seeing what Mark Mehaffey chooses for the show. Every judge and juror has a different eye and every show teaches you something new, whether you are accepted or not.

In a strange twist of fate, I am a (new) signature member who has never been accepted in a show in a year in which a (live) Convention took place. My first acceptance was in 2017 when Hurricane Irma caused a cancellation of the festivities. In 2018, we moved from Key West to Pensacola and I lugged my entries in the car "just in case," to no avail. In 2019, I attended my first Convention and fulfilled a longtime dream by attending Carol Carter's workshop. I tried not to take it personally that she did not pick my artwork for the Exhibition. Happily, my paintings in 2020 and 2021 were chosen for the Annual Exhibitions, but due to CoVid19, we had no live Conventions. If anyone else has this strange distinction, let me know!

Of special note to those aspiring to become Signature Members, the Board has proposed a change to the FWS Online Show as it relates to that goal:

The Florida Watercolor Society conducts an annual Online Show to target emerging artists in Florida and to promote and encourage excellence for Florida Non-Signature Member Artists. In 2022, we are asking membership whether they would like to add a further benefit to the Exhibition by allowing a ONE TIME awarding of a point toward Signature Membership status to the artists who win awards. This means that if you are chosen as one of the three top award winners or receive an honorable mention in the Online Non-Signature Member Show, you would advance one step toward receiving Signature Member Status. This change will require a change to the FWS Bylaws. We are currently updating the Bylaws for other recent revisions and will be reporting back to you in the June newsletter about additional changes for your consideration and vote. Please keep an eye out for the June newsletter and let your opinion be heard!

I hope your first paintings of the New Year are going well. Save one to enter in April!

The works are featured in the Crescendo Gallery through April 27th. The displayed works can be seen at any time.

If you haven't seen the full exhibition in Coral Springs last fall, it is definitely worth the trip to catch some of these top works before being returned to the artists.

Next year's Traveling Exhibition, with selections from the 51st Annual FWS Exhibition in Punta Gorda through November 12th, will travel to two venues after the full exhibition closes. Venues planned for next fall are in South Miami Beach, with a reception on Tuesday November 15th, followed by the last leg of the exhibit in a newly expanded gallery in the Ormond Beach Area. 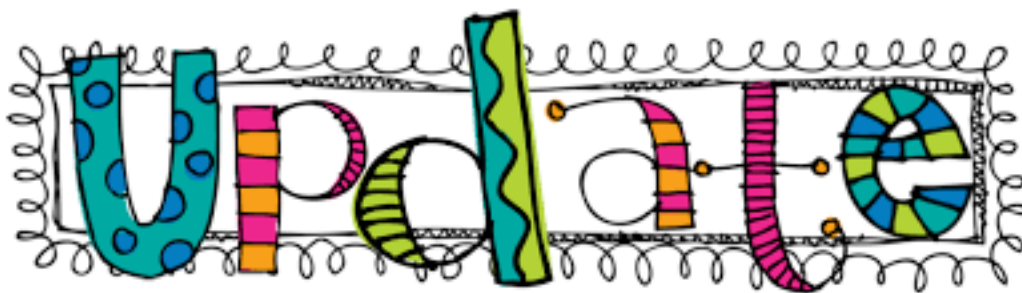
2023 FWS CONVENTION

FWS has a Special Exhibit at Tampa International Airport in Conjunction with its 50th Anniversary



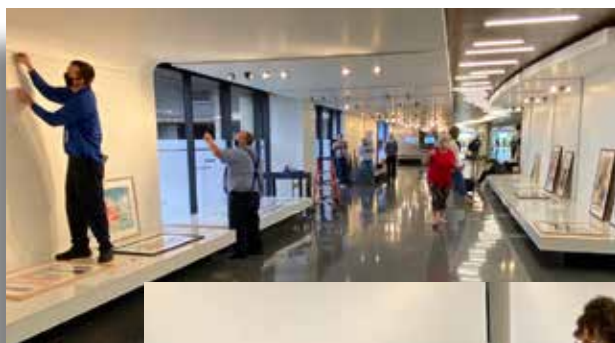
Florida Watercolor Society is excited that this year it has been able to add a special exhibit to showcase its artists.
